1. EVENT TITLE DATE & VENUE

The event shall be known as SCCSA 2021 Season Finale and will be conducted on the 20th November 2021 at Mallala Motorsport Park, South Australia. This event is held in conjunction with the Motorsport Australia SA Auto Test Panel.

You can choose to run up to any two 2 disciplines on the day but these need to be finalised by the close of entries.

2. ORGANISATION & STATUS

Held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA including Appendices, the National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia, the Circuit Race Standing Regulations (CSRS), and the Motorsport Australia Sporting Car Club of SA Inc. 2021 State Motor Racing Championship Series Regulations. This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with all necessary Motorsport Australia COVID-19 Return to Race strategy requirements, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations or Bulletins that may be issued.

This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Motorsport Australia Safety 1st and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at www.motorsport.org.au.

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia in relation to the Event. Further details can be found in the Motorsport Australia Insurance Handbook, available at www.motorsport.org.au.

This Event is a Multi-Club Event.

4. CIRCUIT DETAILS

Length: 2.6km
Direction: Clockwise

Track Density: In accordance with Mallala Motor Sport Park, track licence.

5. LICENCE REQUIREMENTS

Competitors must hold the minimum of a current Motorsport Australia licence to compete.

- Regularity Speed Licence
- Super Sprint Speed Licence
- Race Circuit Licence with provisional endorsement

If you wish to compete in more than one discipline, the highest licence grade will be applicable. Motorsport Australia competition licences will be checked as part of the entry process.

Competitors from New Zealand may be eligible to enter under the Trans Tasman Agreement. Entries from International competitors will be accepted, subject to being granted a visa from Motorsport Australia or their home ASN.

6. ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

Each competing vehicle shall be such as complies with the specifications of 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 5th or 6th Category vehicles as outlined in the current Motorsport Australia Circuit Race Standing Regulations and Motorsport Australia Manual.

Fuel shall be in accordance with Schedule G of the Motorsport Australia Manual.

Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with the noise restrictions in the Circuit Race Standing Regulations. The Clerk of Course shall be the Judge of Fact for noise restrictions and facts to be judged in the Circuit Race Standing Regulations.

Entry is via the Motorsport Australia Event Entry portal (<u>www.motorsport.org.au/login</u>). Please ensure all entry details are completed in full, including your Club Membership Details, Vehicle Details including Class.

Your entry will be complete once all documentation and payment have been received.



Late entries (entries received after 10th November 2021) will be accepted at the discretion of the event organiser and may incur a late fee.

Refusal of entries shall be in accordance with the NCR's & the relevant Category Sporting Regulations. The maximum number of entries will be 200.

ENTRIES OPEN UPON THE PUBLICATION OF THE SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS.

The entry of multiple cars and multiple drivers can be accepted at the sole discretion of the Organisers.

Entrants will be allowed up to a maximum of four (4) pit crew for this event. Nominated pit crew must be notified at the time of entry and must complete a Motorsport Australia Disclaimer and Venue Disclaimer prior to being accepted.

Limited spectators will be allowed to this event and all must sign in by scanning the event QR code. If you are not able to scan into the venue, you will be asked to provide your contact details prior to entry to the venue.

8. ENTRY REFUNDS

Entry fees are refundable under the following circumstances:

- a. In the case of competitor's cars withdrawn by written advice to motorsport@sportingcarclub.com.au not later than five (5) day before the event
- b. In the case of abandonment, cancellation or postponement of the Event, in accordance with the NCR's.
- c. International competitors who have been unsuccessful in the granting of a visa from Motorsport Australia or their home ASN.

9. TRACK TIME

It is envisaged that there will be at least four (4) track sessions for each discipline with the duration time to be determined at the close of entries. Further Regulations will be issued as soon as practicable following close of entries and will include the Final Schedule. The Organisers reserve the right to combine or delete categories.

10. AUTOMATIC TIMING

The Organisers utilise an automatic timing system, which requires all race vehicles to be fitted with an operating Dorian DATA-1 timing transmitter anytime the race vehicle is on the track, which is the Competitor's responsibility. DATA-1 transmitters are available for purchase from Dorian Industries, 6/29 Graham Court, Hoppers Crossing, VIC 3129. They can be hired locally from Barry Frost, c/o Timing/Austin 7 Club at Mallala for a fee of \$50.00 per event. The correct Dorian number must be recorded on Event Entry.

11. GARAGES / PADDOCK AREA

All Paddock Garages are to be reserved and paid for as part of the entry process (www.motorsport.org.au/login) and will be allocated in accordance with Government distancing regulations. The paddock will be managed to ensure categories are located as close as possible. Please note: Not all individual garaging allocation requests can be met.

There should a clear area, at least 4 metres (2 car spaces) between each paddock spot.

12. PROTESTS

Competitors are reminded of their protest rights; refer the NCR's of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

13. SCHEDULE

The full Schedule including briefing times is provided with the Further Regulations following the close of entries.

14. MEDICAL

Will be operating as per Motorsport Australia Medical Services/Requirements - Medical Services at Motor Sport Events. 3.1.4.3 Alternative for Club, Multi-Club or State Championship Race Meetings.



15. ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of any drug or other banned substance and subject to a penalty for a breach of the Australian National Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.

Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day. The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.

16. PARADES / PASSENGER RIDES / DEMONSTRATIONS

Any Parade or Demonstration will be conducted in accordance with the NCR's and in adherence to the State COVID requirements at the time of the Event.

This Event may include a Motorsport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) that shall be run under and in accordance with the Dual-Occupancy Checklist available at: https://motorsport.org.au/covid-19/competitors.

17. COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS

Under no circumstances should anyone with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 attend the event. This includes any fever, respiratory symptoms, and shortness of breath, sore throat, cough, fatigue, or lack of sense of smell.

Under no circumstances should anyone attend the Event if they have been:

- a. Overseas in the previous 14 days; or
- b. In contact with someone who has been overseas in the previous 14 days; or
- c. In contact with a known COVID-19 positive case in the previous 14 days
- d. In contact with someone or visited a known hotspot within the last 14 days
- e. Requested to self-isolate by Health Authorities.

18. COVID-19 SAFETY

- Drivers and Pit Crew are encouraged to download the COVID Safe App.
- Stay at home if you have any cold or flu symptoms.
- Maintain social distancing measure of 1.5 metres and do not gather in groups.
- Wash your hands frequently and dispose of any paper towels that you have used in the bin.
- Sanitiser is provided at various locations around the pit area, please use it regularly.
- If you develop symptoms while at the track, you must immediately isolate from everyone other than immediate family, inform the COVID-19 Checker at the track, pack up and leave.
